### Catherine Davis - Outstanding Volunteer Award



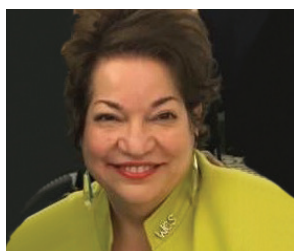
